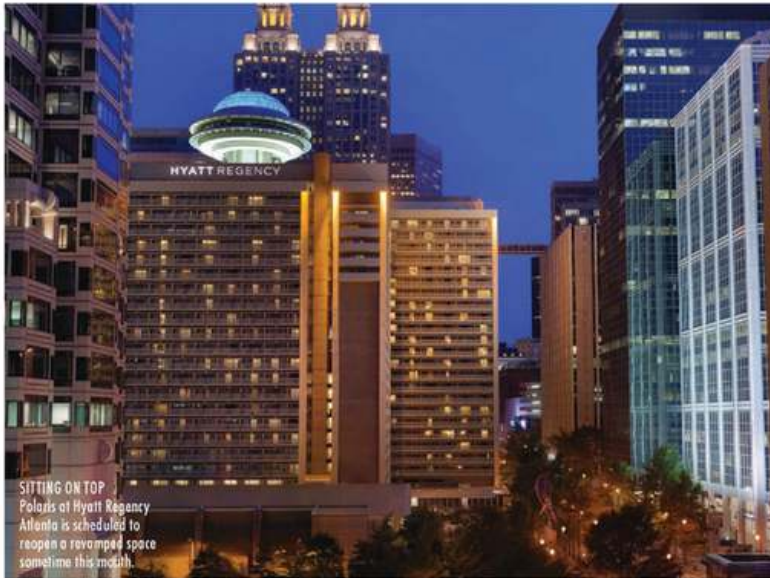

SAVOR THE FIVE-STAR VIEWS AT FOUR OF ATLANTA'S NEWEST SKY-HIGH RESTAURANTS. —*Kate Parham*

1. Big Sky Buckhead

With its alluring second-story perch and central locale, it will be a tempting spot to sip (and chow) come spring. And, with Hector Santiago developing the menu of savory fare—as in, the return of Santiago's famously fab pork belly buns—things are certainly looking up in Buckhead. 3201 Cains Hill Place NW, 404.481.5168, bigskybuckhead.com

2. Flip Burger Boutique

Nowhere else in Atlanta's edgy Poncey-Highland hood does a rooftop patio like this exist. Celebric chef Richard Blais' latest outpost marries his famous avant-garde burgers (think steak tartare patties piled with fried eggs under melty manchego) with equally mouthwatering 360-degree views of the skyline. 644 N. 3. Nikolai's Roof

A million dollars can do a lot for a restaurant. After a plethora of postcard-worthy renos, the behemoth 30th-floor hot spot is reopening, complete with floor-to-ceiling windows revealing panoramic views from Turner Field to Stone Mountain.
